Biography

The adventurous and exploratory music of bilingual Albertan Ariane Mahryke Lemire is a blend of vivid lyrics and fresh melodies. It is folk-poetry with a touch of rock, often laced with Beatnik flavours and at times a little country. Her authentic and natural stage presence, sprinkled with light anecdotes and intimate musings, captivates audiences and invites them to journey between laughter and poignant reflection.

A seasoned musician, she has performed at major musical events: the *Vancouver Olympics*; *Festival en chanson de Petite Vallée* in Gaspésie; *Coup de coeur francophone* in Montreal; European festivals such as *Les Rencontres d'Astaffort* in France; appearances on several television broadcast artist profiles (*UNIS TV, CBC, SRC, BRBR, Sask Tel Max*).

Four time nominee and two time *Western Canadian Music Award* winner, Ariane is a prominent figure in both the English and French music scenes in Western Canada. During the summer of 2017 she was part of the artist in residence program at the *National Music Centre* in Calgary where she explored new works and gave a workshop performance.

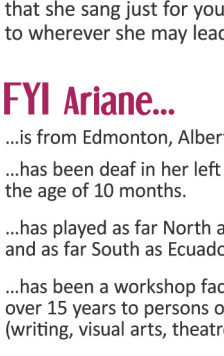
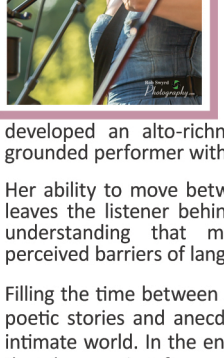
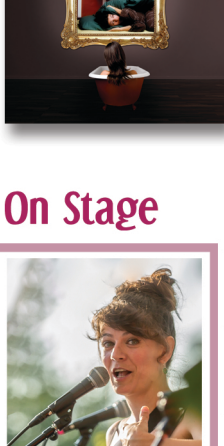

Through the cheeky bat of an eyelid or by the lift of her foot in exuberant joy, it's clear that Ariane delights in captivating her audience. She has the peculiar quality of being both inviting and provoking.

When she first hit the music scene, Ariane Mahryke had a beautiful youthful giddiness. Over the years she has become a seasoned musician: her voice has gotten even more melodious; her voice has developed an alto-richness; and she has become a grounded performer with a strong stage presence.

Her ability to move between English and French never leaves the listener behind. She deftly leads you to an understanding that music really does transcend perceived barriers of language.

Filling the time between songs with precise and equally poetic stories and anecdotes, Ariane wraps you in her intimate world. In the end, you are left with the feeling that she sang just for you, and you long to follow blindly to wherever she may lead you next.
